## WENATCHEE SCHOOL DISTRICT ATHLETIC CONTRACT

The rules and regulations of the WIAA, the Wenatchee School District and rules specific to each sport shall govern students in grades 6-12 who participate in athletics/cheer/dance and drill of the Wenatchee School District.

Participation in the athletic programs offered by the Wenatchee School District is completely voluntary. Involvement requires commitment to academic excellence, citizenship, as well as teammates, school, and community.

The Wenatchee School District believes that Athletics is a privilege, not a right. Enjoyment of these privileges is predicated on the student-athlete's willingness to uphold the following rules of conduct.

### THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE SET FORTH BY THE STUDENT-ATHLETE HANDBOOK. AS A STUDENT ATHLETE YOU MUST . . .

1. Be eligible under the WIAA rules.
2. Be less than 20 years of age on Sept. 1 for the fall season, Dec. 1 for the winter season and March 1 for the spring season.  
Be under 15 years of age prior to June 1 of the previous school year for middle school.
3. Be a regular member of the school you represent, enrolled half time or more, including the previous semester.
4. Be eligible academically. If not, you will follow the expectations of academic probation.
5. Be a bona fide resident of the Wenatchee School District.
6. Successfully complete a physical examination each year.
7. Be an amateur in the sport in which you participate.
8. Not possess, use or sell legend drugs and/or controlled substances.
9. Conduct yourself appropriately during school as well as during any school activity.
10. Complete (or have scheduled) school discipline prior to participation.
11. Attend all scheduled practices, contests, or meetings.
12. Attend school all day of contests unless pre-arranged/excused with the attendance office.
13. Travel to and from all contests with the group when transportation is provided unless cleared through the Athletic Office.
14. Return all school owned uniforms and equipment in a timely manner.
15. Abide by the rules set forth by each sport.

### THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE SET FORTH BY THE WENATCHEE SCHOOL DISTRICT. AS A STUDENT ATHLETE YOU MUST . . .

1. **NOT** consume, possess, or transmit alcoholic beverages or tobacco products in any form.
2. **NOT** knowingly be in the presence of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or illegal substances in any form that are being introduced or used unlawfully.
3. Remove yourself from the presence of these illegal activities as soon as reasonably possible after you become aware these activities are taking place.

### STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTANDING

I have read and understand the rules and regulations as written in the Student Athlete Handbook.

I agree to follow all standards and expectations set forth in the Student Athlete Handbook.

I understand that once signed, this contract will be in effect for my athletic career while in grades 6-8 and grades 9-12.

I understand that the contract is in effect from the first day of fall practices until the last day of school.

I understand violations are cumulative for each grade grouping.

I understand that I have the option to self refer on a first violation (if I meet expectations of self refer).

I understand that if I falsify any signature on any required forms, I will lose eligibility for that activity.
